

THE WORDSWORTH GRAVE

WILLIAM WORDSWORTH, born at Rydal Mount, Westmorland, 7th April 1770, died at Rydal Mount, 23rd April 1850. He was a poet, a philosopher, and a statesman. He was the first of the English Romantic poets, and his poetry is characterized by its simplicity and its directness. He was also a philosopher, and his philosophy is based on the idea of the "egotistical sublime." He was a statesman, and he was one of the founders of the English Romantic movement.
