

PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE (ACTIVE TO PASSIVE VOICE)

Active voice: Subject (doer) + is/am/are + V1+ing + object

Passive voice: The object (receiver of the action) + is/am/are + being + V3 + (by the doer)

ACTIVE: THE POLICE ARE INTERROGATING HIM RIGHT NOW.
(SUBJECT) (ACTIVE VERB FORM) (OBJECT)

PASSIVE: HE IS BEING INTERROGATED BY THE POLICE RIGHT NOW.
(OBJECT OF THE VERB) (PASSIVE VERB FORM)
(IT IS OPTIONAL TO MENTION THE DOER OF THE ACTION IN THE PASSIVE VOICE AS IT IS NOT WHAT THE SENTENCE FOCUSES ON. IT CAN BE LEFT OUT TOO)

Active voice: A robot is serving food in this hotel.

Passive voice: Food is being served by a robot in this hotel.

Active voice: They are making a movie about me.

Passive voice: A movie about me is being made by them.
