"And all went to be taxed, every one into his own city." Luke 2:3



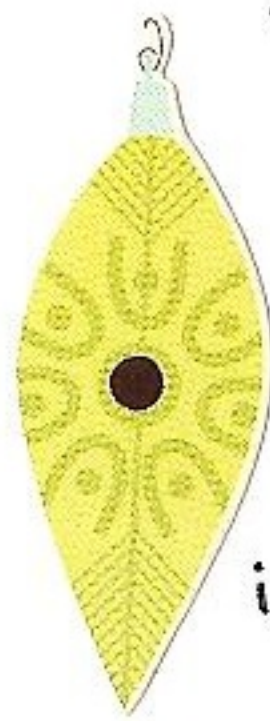
