Color Temperature in Kelvin	Color Appearance	Atmosphere	Commonly Used
5000 – 6000 K	Noon Daylight or Direct Sun	Invigorating, attentive, and vibrant	Facilities, basements, and garages
3000 – 4000 K	Bright White or Cool White	Neutral, pure, and efficient	Entryways, bathrooms, retail stores, and offices
2700 – 3000 K	Warm White or Yellow-White	Peaceful, welcoming glow, comforting, and cozy	Indoor areas at homes, particularly bedrooms and living rooms
1800 K	Candlelight	Warm, relaxing, and fiery	Bedrooms, clubs, and hotels
