```
>>> lst2=["a","b","c"]
>>> lst2
['a', 'b', 'c']
>>> type(lst2)
<class 'list'>
>>> strlst2=''.join(str(e) for e in lst2)
>>> strlst2
'abc'
>>> type(str1)
<class 'str'>

>>> jn=["wclass",
{"student":{"name":"Linda Jones","legacySkill":"Access, VB 5.0"}
},
{ "student":{"name":"Adam Davidson","legacySkill":"Cobol, MainFrame"}
},
{"student":{"name":"Charles Boyer","legacySkill":"HTML, XML"}
}]
>>> type(jn)
<class 'list'>
>>> strgjn=''.join(str(e) for e in jn)
>>> type(strgjn)
<class 'str'>
>>> strgjn
"wclass{'student': {'name': 'Linda Jones', 'legacySkill': 'Access, VB 5.0'}}{'student':
