- 1 Beginning of the Indiction, that is, the New Year; Commemoration of Our Holy Father Symeon the Stylite (459) and His Mother Martha; and the Synaxis of the Most Holy Mother of God of Misenos
- 2 The Holy Martyr Mamas (275); Our Venerable Father John the Faster, Patriarch of Constantinople (595)
- 3 The Holy Priest-Martyr Anthimus, Bishop of Nicomedia (303); Our Venerable Father Theocritus, Fellow-Ascetic of the Great Euthymius (467)
- 4 The Holy Priest-Martyr Babylon, Bishop of Antioch (250); the Holy Prophet Moses Who Saw God
