



Spring Craft

Handprint lily

Supplies needed:

- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Tape or glue
- Pencil
- Green pipe cleaners (or straws)
- Stapler



Trace a child's hand on construction paper.
Cut the tracing out.



Curl each of the fingers
around a pencil.



Using the palm of the handprint, form a
cone (with the fingers curling outwards).
Glue or tape the cone together.

Staple the flower to a pipe cleaner or a
drinking straw.



Draw some leaves on green construction paper,
then cut them out.



Staple or tape the leaves to the straw.
Make a few of these flowers for
a beautiful bouquet.
