


## Spring Vegetable Planting Dates

**Instructions:** To use this chart, write in the day of your average last spring frost on the line above the 00 column. From there, fill in the dates before that frost date, to the left of the 00 column, each 10 days prior to the last. For example, if your last frost date is April 15, write April 15 above the 00 column. Then write April 5 over the 10 column (because it's 10 days before April 15), March 26 in the next column (20) to the left (because it's twenty days before April 5), etc. Do the same thing (now *adding* 10 days per column) to the columns to the right of the frost date (the 10 column to the right of the frost date would read April 25, etc.) – adapted from VPI's "Virginia Gardener's Handbook" 11/1994.
