General Observations

The pattern is not slavishly precise. e.g. Christ's promise to come is found twice in the epilogue, but once in the prologue. The pattern follows a method but the method is not more important than the message. Don't worry about the fact that the 'divisions' do not line up with the chapter breaks. The chapter breaks were not given by God but were added later.
