Affirmative sentence

- He has been eating the food for 15 minutes.
- He has been searching me since morning.
- He has been inviting us for three days.
- Ali has been playing hockey since morning.

Negative Sentence

- · He has not been doing this work.
- · We have not been plucking the flowers since morning.
- They have not been helping them for three years.
- Jan has not been reading newspaper for fifteen minutes.

Interrogative sentence

- Have he been plucking flowers for 15 minutes?
- · Have they been washing the clothes sine Friday?
- · Have they been cheating us for two days?
- · Have Jan been waiting for you since January?
