

# PRESENT CONTINUOUS

**FORM** [am/is/are + present participle]

Examples:

- You **are** **watching** TV.
- Are** you **watching** TV?
- You **are** **not** **watching** TV.



- Express the idea that something is happening now ----> You are learning English now.
- Longer Actions in Progress Now ----> I am studying to become a dentist.
- Near Future ----> We're meeting some friends after work.
- Repetition and Irritation with "Always": ----> She is always coming to class late.  
You're constantly talking. Be quiet!
