Edmund Tudor & Margaret Beaufort

- Born 28<sup>th</sup> Jan 1547
- linked to royalty on dad side - Granoma Catherine married Henry V before his Granddad
- claim to throne through a woman made it weak
- 1471 (Edward VI on throne) Henry fled to Brittany  
 ↳ lived in exile (12 yrs) protected by Duke of ...
- 1472, mother married Lord Thomas Stanley - his mother got a place at court
- 1583, Henry lived in Paris gaining support.
- supporters: Bishop of Ely, Richard Fox, Earl of Oxford
- financial support from: French King, Charles VIII

as a Lancastrian claimant

more structural analysis

- by Lord Thomas Stanley - key part = 4,000 men comm
- Both sides met @ Bosworth & brother Sir William
- Richard's forces had upper hand but Richard's commander (Duke of Norfolk) died
- Henry convinced the Stanleys to switch sides
- William Stanley sent his cavalry to attack
- The Earl of Northumberland (supporter) did not protect the king
- ↳ William died by attacking cavalry.
