

## FUTURE CONTINUOUS TENSE GRAMMAR



The future continuous tense is used to express action at a particular moment in the future. However, the action will not have finished at the moment.

## **Positive Statements**

SUBJECT	WILL BE	VERB + ing	REST OF THE SENTENCE
	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
You	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
He	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
Tom	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
The boy	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
She	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
Anna	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
The girl	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
We	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
You	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
They	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.
The children	will be	studying	at 4 p.m. tomorrow.

Notice that we use 'will be' and the verb + ing for all subjects.
