

Division Terms

Let's look at 485 divided by 5 again.

5 goes into 48 nine times with 3 left over. You bring down the 5 from 485 to make 35. Then 5 goes into 35 seven times. Your answer of how many times 5 goes into 485, or the quotient, is 97.
