

PERCENTAGES WORKSHEET Practice

To find the percentage of a number or an amount, you should _____ the percent value to the original amount. You can also convert the percent value to a decimal to make it easier to multiply. To convert a percent value to a decimal, take the percent value, such as 10% and move the decimal point _____ spots to the _____. So, for example, 10% becomes .10.

Example problem:

Find 10% of 35.

$$35 \times 10\% \rightarrow 35 \times .10 = 3.5$$

Therefore, 3.5 is 10% of 35.
