

Client-side Filter Expression



Define an expression to filter the data in the List.

The expression must be a Javascript expression that evaluates to `true` or `false` for each row in the List.

If the expression is `true`, the row is show. If `false`, the row is hidden.

Your expression can refer to fields in the current row using the `data.` prefix. (Note the prefix and field names are case sensitive)

Examples:

`data.State == 'MA'` - will show only the records where the 'State' field is equal to 'MA'

`data.State == 'MA' && data.Name.substr(0,1) == 'A'` - records where 'State' is 'MA' and first character of 'Name' is 'A'

Notice that we use double equals `==`, single quotes and `&&` for the 'and' operator because this is a Javascript expression.

`data.State == 'MA'`
