


Solidify the corners and turns with shorts stitches.


Cut all around the cat body, 5 mm away from the seam.




Clip at the ears, the neck, under the arms and between the legs.




Turn your cat inside out. This step can be long, take your time. Start with the legs, the rest of the body will follow. You can use the straw or the end of a pen to help you get the members out. When it's done, push the seams in place with your fingers.



Place the face guide on your cat and mark the placement of the eyes and the ears. Take the guide off, and trace the eyelids and eyebrows by hand.




Sew the ears shut with a short running stitch so the fill stays out.



Embroider the nose with red floss. Start with a small tric

Mark the eyebrows with a running stitch.


Refer to the drawing to help. Always start and end with a hidden knot.



THE PANTS (OR SHORTS)




You can add lace to the bottom!



Place the two legs right sides together and sew the crotch

Place the sewn crotches on top of each other and sew the inseam (from the bottom of one leg to the other).



Turn the pants inside out. Fold the vembroidery floss sew a large running. Knot the ends.
