Text recovery language:



When a PDF file contains scanned pages or graphics that look like text, you can use optical text recovery to create an editable document. Additionally, you may apply OCR to accurately recreate the text in MS Word when the font information in the PDF file is incomplete (resulting in corrupt or incorrect characters).

Recognize PDF text: Seeing garbled text in the converted document? Choose the level of text recovery to be used for non-standard encoding. Every character Problem characters only None Recognize content of PDF pages: No text in the converted document? Choose the level of optical text recovery to be used on text-like images.
