JULIAN CALENDARS

Julian calendar is the 365-day calendar Julius Caesar made official in 46 B.C

An average year in Julian calendar is 365.25 days

There was a leap year every four years

GREGORIAN CALENDARS

Gregorian calendar is the calendar currently used in most parts of the world

An average year in Gregorian calendar is 365.2425 days

A year that is exactly divisible by 4 is a leap year; however, a year that is evenly divisible by 4 and 100 is a leap year only if it is also exactly divisible by 400
